

Projects & Philanthropy



An integral part of our organization is community involvement and support. Each year CN&N donates thousands of dollars to local service organizations, schools, fire departments and other community groups and causes. Proceeds from the annual Holiday Boutique generate funds for disbursement to qualifying projects and programs.

Among those receiving funds in recent years are: Mountain Resource Center, Mountain Peace Shelter, Beaver Ranch Community Park, Intermountain Humane Society, Pleasant Park Grange Schoolhouse, Park County Search and Rescue, Jefferson County Horse Evacuation Assistance team and dozens of local community organizations.

Groups qualifying for funding may receive gifts on an annual basis, while other specific projects may be awarded funds by CN&N. Disbursement of funds is determined annually, based on income from the Boutique and according to criteria approved by the membership.

Over \$100,000 has been awarded over the last few years.

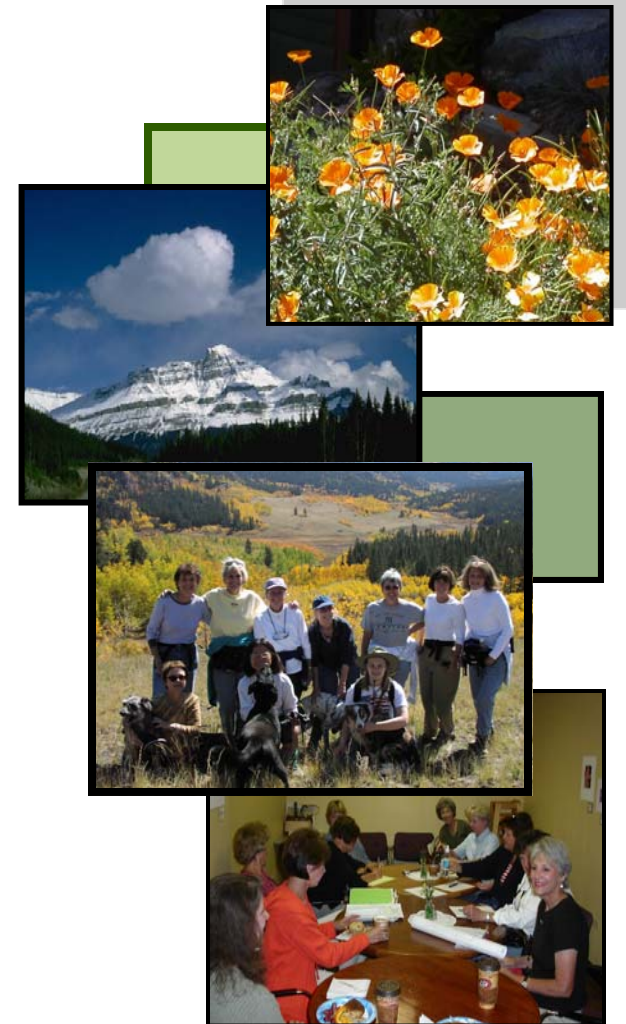

Special Interest Groups
