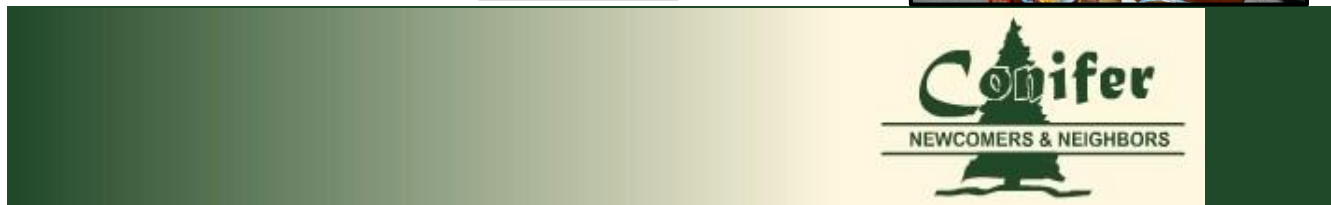
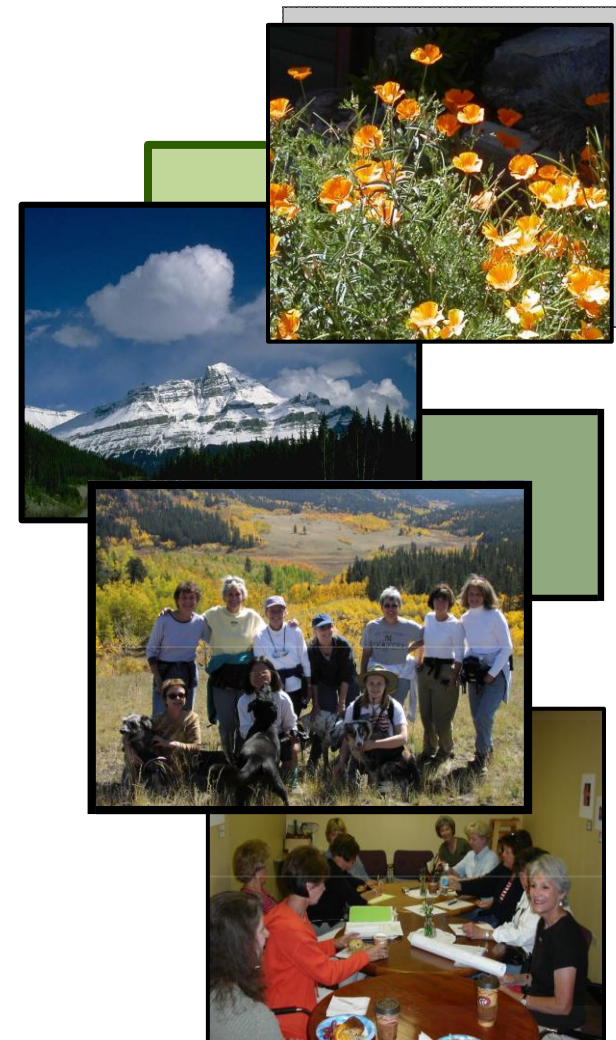
An integral part of our organization is community involvement and support. Each year CN&N donates thousands of dollars to local organizations, schools, fire departments, etc. Proceeds from the annual Holiday Boutique generate funds for disbursement to qualifying projects and programs.

Among those receiving funds in recent years are: Mountain Resource Center, Mountain Peace Works, Beaver Ranch Community Park, Intermountain Humane Society, Pleasant Park Grange Schoolhouse, Park County Search and Rescue, Jefferson County Horse Evacuation Assistance team, Boy Scouts, Mount Evans Hospice, Bootstraps, and others.

Groups qualifying for funding may receive gifts on an annual basis, while other specific projects may be awarded funds by CN&N based on income from the Boutique and according to the criteria approved by the membership.

Over \$200,000 has been awarded over the last few years.

In addition, CN&N Garden Club developed and maintains the flower beds at the front entrance of Conifer High School. CN&N members often volunteer to assist at community events, charity projects and other community endeavors.

Special Interest Groups

Book Talk meets the fourth Monday of the month, to discuss current book selections chosen by members.

Touring Lunch Bunch tours sites of interest and dines at regional restaurants on the 2nd Friday of each month.

Wine Tasting meets on the 1st Saturday of each month at individual homes.
