The following are the baked items that are most popular:

COOKIES – EYE APPEALING of ANY KIND, most asked for are **Chocolate Chip**, Oatmeal Raisin, Peanut Butter-- remember: ADD THE CHIPS/NUTS ON TOP

We would like some other types that look eye catching— i.e.--decorated sugar cookies

CAKES – cakes of any kind---but **not** sheet cakes

BROWNIES – big seller, decorate the top
