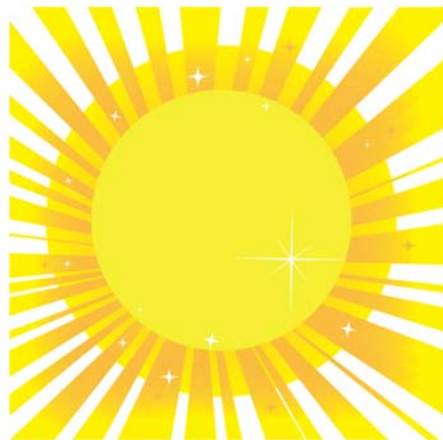
A reminder to please be in contact with our **Boutique** chair, **Jan Powell** as we still have some vacancies in our leadership roles:
